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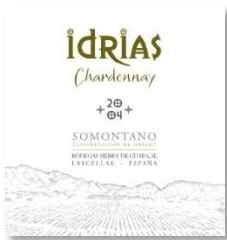
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Idrias Abiego 2008, BODEGAS SIERRA DE GUARA, D.O. SOMONTANO

From the region of Somontano in Northeastern Spain at the foothills of the Pyrenees comes this extraordinary blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. Aged for 6 months in a combination of French and Central European oak, Idrias Abiego is dark ruby colored and yields a pleasant perfume of spice box, cassis, violets, and black currant. Racy and elegant on the palate, it has ample fruit, good balance, and a silky finish. 89 Points Parker. (SRP: \$15)



Idrias Chardonnay 2009, BODEGAS SIERRA DE GUARA, D.O. SOMONTANO

Also from Somontano, this equally-competitive single-estate Chardonnay aged for 2 months in a mix of French and Hungarian oak is light gold-colored, offering up notes of buttered popcorn, poached pear, and white peach with a hint of tropical aromas. On the palate it is medium-bodied with plenty of ripe fruit, lively acidity, and solid length. 88 Points Parker. (SRP: \$15)



Urbina (Crianza, Reserva and Gran Reserva), BODEGAS URBINA, D.O.C. RIOJA

Owned and operated by Pedro Urbina's family for three generations, Urbina's wines represent classic Rioja at its best. Gorgeous and vibrant red fruit aromas dominate the CRIANZA, while dry fruits, figs and leather notes are more prevalent in the 2001 SELECCION RESERVA (90 Points Parker). The GRAN RESERVA 1994 (92 Points Parker) displays a lovely bouquet of cherry blossom, earth notes, spice box, leather, black cherry, and plum. On the palate it is multifaceted, elegant, concentrated, impeccably balanced, and holding strong. It should drink nicely for another 10-15 years if not longer.

Siglo (Crianza, Reserva and Gran Reserva), BODEGAS AGE, D.O.C. RIOJA

Deep, bright red Tempranillo with a touch of Garnacha and Mazuelo. Fresh red berries and flowers on the nose, with a subtle spiciness adding lift. Light-bodied, gently sweet red fruit flavors show a refreshingly tangy edge and a silky texture. Straightforward but juicy wine, and extremely easy to drink. 89 pts. Parker. Siglo's 2004 Reserva and the 2001 Gran Reserva complete the collection with 91 and 92 points respectively. Siglo is produced by bodegas AGE in Fuenmayor.

Lacrimus Rex, BODEGAS SENDERO ROYAL, D.O.C. RIOJA

Modern style Rioja blend made of 75% Grenache produced by 60 year-old estate vineyards and 25% Graciano. Both varietals are vinified separately but undergo malolactic fermentation after blending. Aging is done on 500, 300 and 225 litres barrels for 9 months. The big barrels are from French oak, and the 225 litres American Oak. (SRP: \$12.99)



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Uva Nocturna 2010, BODEGAS EJEANAS, RIBERA DEL GÁLLEGO

100% Tempranillo. Garnet cherry color with bluish flashes showing aromas of blackberry, fruits of the forest and a well-balance, soft after-taste with a refreshing, yet lingering finish. Uva Nocturna is produced by Bodegas Ejeanas, located in North-Eastern Spain near Zaragoza and Huesca. Hand harvesting at night (*nocturna*) is their standard to guarantee the utmost quality of the grapes they pick and the wines they make. **(SRP: \$9.99)**



Tossals 2006, BODEGAS GRIFOLL-DECLARA, D.O. MONTSANT

From the land of Montsant, 2 hours south of Barcelona comes this fantastic blend of old vine Grenache and Carignan, with 15% Cabernet and 12% Tempranillo aged for 12 months in new French oak barrels. 92 points from the Wine Advocate, this Mediterranean marvel is a show in the glass. Opaque purple-colored, the nose exhibits liquid minerality, pencil lead, espresso, truffle, spice box, black cherry and plum. **(SRP: \$30)**



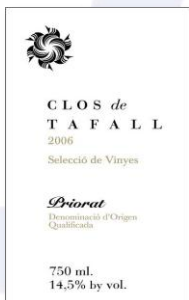
Tossals Junior 2006, BODEGAS GRIFOLL-DECLARA, D.O. MONTSANT

The 2006 Tossals Junior is 33% Garnacha, 33% Cariñena, and the balance Cabernet Sauvignon and Tempranillo. Aged for 12 months in French oak barrels, it offers up an enticing nose of slate/mineral, lavender, and comfiture of black fruits. Rich, full-bodied, and flavorful, it will evolve for 2-3 years and will be at its best from 2012 to 2021. Produced by Bodegas Grifoll-Declara, a small 20 acre estate in Montsant. 90 Points Parker. **(SRP: \$20)**



Clos del Gos 2010, BODEGAS GRIFOLL-DECLARA, D.O. MONTSANT

The 2010 Clos del Gos is made up of 70% Garnacha, 20% Carignan and 10% Syrah given a few months exposure to French oak. It is a savory, forward wine displaying pleasant red fruit aromas and flavors in a style meant for drinking over the next 3 years. An extraordinary value from a prime appellation. Produced by Bodegas Grifoll-Declara, a family-owned and operated 20 acre estate in Montsant. 92 points Wilfred Wong. **(SRP: \$18)**



Clos Tafall 2009, BODEGAS CLOS BERENGUER, D.O.C. PRIORAT

Clos Berenguer del Molar is an excellent example of the quality that's coming out of Priorat these days. The winery's entry level wine, Clos de Tafall, is made with grapes from 80 year-old Grenache and Carignan vines plus 10% of Cabernet Sauvignon aged for 12 months in French oak barrels. Cedar, spice box, incense, lavender, black cherry, and black plum aromas in the nose. This concentrated, lengthy wine will be at its best from 2012 to 2017. 89 Points Parker. 91 Points Wilfred Wong. **(SRP: \$20)**



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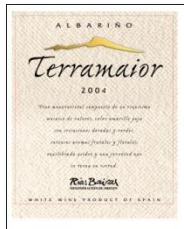
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El Xamfrà Brut 2008, CAVAS EL XAMFRA, D.O. CAVA

This beautifully packaged BRUT from San Sadurní D'Anoia, the capital of CAVA, is a blend of Macabeo (40%), Xarel-lo (40%) and Parellada (20%) aged for 18 months in the bottle before its release. With only 20,000 bottles produced, this elegant Cava shows exuberant aromas of apple and pear combined with pastry-shop aromas. The tiny, needle-thin bubbles, its dense persistent finish and the perfect balance between alcohol, acidity and sugar confirm this Cava's extraordinary quality. **(SRP: \$15)**



Terramaior Albariño 2010, ADEGAS TERRAMAIOR, D.O. RIAS BAIXAS

Lovely, enticing nose of lime, pear, white pepper, sea salt and seashells. Delicately soft, almost cloud-like on the palate showing grapefruit, lime and brilliant minerality. Finishes long, slightly tart and crisp with juicy acidity. Beautifully balanced wine. Adegas Terramaior is a small estate in the Salnes region producing 90,000 bottles per year. **(SRP: \$20)**



Lagar de Robla, VINOS DE ARGANZA, D.O. BIERZO

The 2008 Lagar de Robla Premium is made with 100% Mencía grapes produced by old vines in the region of Bierzo with an average age of 30 years. This big red spent 18 months in American oak and a year in the bottle before its release. This is the most complex wine made by Vinos de Arganza, displaying density, opulence, and length. This pleasure-bent effort can be enjoyed now but will drink well for a decade. 91 points Parker. Vinos de Arganza is a family-owned and operated winery located in Villafranca del Bierzo. **(SRP: \$20)**



Señorio del Sotillo, BODEGAS ARROYO, D.O. RIBERA DEL DUERO

Señorio del Sotillo comes from Bodegas Arroyo's 100 hectares of vineyards in the village of Sotillo de la Ribera at an average altitude of nearly 3,000 ft. Señorío del Sotillo Joven (87 points Parker) is an excellent value, a savory, forward Tempranillo that displays the lush fruit of the great 2009 vintage. The Roble (88 points Parker) spent several months in barrel and reveals greater concentration, depth, and length, while the Crianza (89 points Parker) is more structured, having spent 12 months in oak. Cedar, spice box, violets, and blackberry aromas with spicy flavors and good length.

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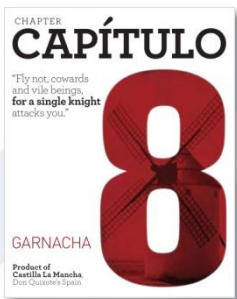
Maza Cruz Tinto 2008, DEHESA DE LOS LLANOS, TIERRA DE CASTILLA

43% Merlot, 23% Tempranillo, 21% Cabernet Sauvignon and 13% Syrah aged for 4 months in medium toast French oak barrels. Red cherry color with violet notes, intense berry and plum aromas. A very pleasant wine with creamy notes and an elegant, lengthy finish. 88 Points Parker. Produced at one of the most extraordinary properties we have ever visited, Dehesa de los Llanos is a 10,000 Ha. estate founded in the 17th century by Franciscan monks and owned by the Larios Group since the early 1900's. This breathtaking hacienda still preserves the original buildings but is equipped with state-of-the-art technology, not only for winemaking, but also for the production of Manchego cheese from milk produced by their very own sheep. **(SRP: \$19.99)**



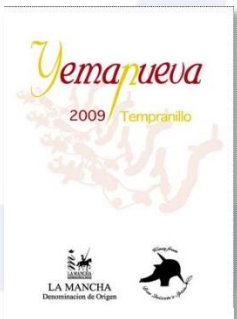
Mureda 2010, BODEGAS MUREDA, TIERRA DE CASTILLA

This recently finished state-of-the-art winery in the region of Valdepeñas is one of the latest additions to our portfolio. Making extraordinary young wines with just a touch of oak, Bodegas Mureda represents the perfect blend of modernity and tradition. Mureda's reds are fruit driven, vibrant and refreshing, yet structured and complex. The winery produces a line of monovarietal wines including Tempranillo, Merlot (86 Pts Parker), Syrah (87 Pts Parker), Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc, in addition to a gorgeous Tempranillo Crianza. **(SRP: Varietals: \$9.99. Crianza: \$12.99)**



Capitulo 8 2010, BODEGAS TINTORALBA, D.O. ALMANSA

100% Garnacha Tintorera from 30-50 year-old vines growing at an altitude of nearly 3,000 feet and with yields of under 1.5 Tons/Ha. Impenetrable thick purple/violet color with a dark blue sheen, delicious aromas of small fruits and a slight fresh breeze of balsamic tones. Produced by Bodegas Tintoralba in D.O. Almansa, in the province of Albacete. 90 points from Wilfred Wong and 88 points from Parker. Capitulo 8 is a private label made for a large California retail chain, but the same product can be packaged under a different brand within weeks. **(SRP: \$11.99)**



Yemanueva 2009, BODEGAS LA TERCIA, D.O. LA MANCHA

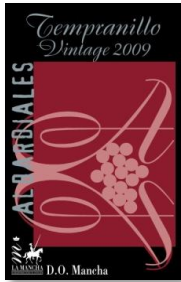
Made of 100% certified **organic** tempranillo grapes from 25-year-old head pruned vineyards. Bright and clean ruby colour with intense, complex aromas of ripe fruit, marmalade, roasted coffee, pepper and balsamic touches. In the palate it is ample, sweet, warm and balanced with a persistent finish. Total production of 40,000 bottles. 89 points Wilfred Wong. Made by Bodegas La Tercia, a unique and charming family-owned winery operated by the three Sanchez-Mateos brothers. The family owns and exploits a total of 40 Has of old vine tempranillo and Airen ranging from 25-year old plants all the way up to 110 yr-old prefiloxera vineyards. **(SRP: \$11.99)**



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Albardiales 2010, COOP. SAN ANTONIO ABAD, D.O. LA MANCHA

Made in the northern part of La Mancha D.O. in the province of Toledo by the well established Cooperative San Antonio Abad, Albardiales is a young, fruit-driven wine, offering bright red berry and raspberry aromas in the nose, deep, vibrant and lively flavors on the palate, well balanced and quite refreshing on the finish. 89 points Wilfred Wong. An outstanding value from an up-and-coming region. **(SRP: \$8.99)**



TE AMO TEMPRANILLO 2011, D.O. LA MANCHA / ALMANSA

Private label developed using young, fruit-forward wines from Castilla La Mancha specifically targeting the US female consumer. All TE AMO wines are estate bottled and using wines produced by existing suppliers in order to guarantee the utmost quality and consistency in the bottle. The TE AMO line (“I Love You” in Spanish) includes a young 100% Tempranillo, a 100% Garnacha both with an \$8.99 price point, and a Tempranillo Crianza with 10% Syrah aged for 12 months in French oak barrels and 6 months in the bottle before its release. **(SRP: \$8.99 / Crianza: \$11.99)**
